5. Update on Arena Events / Procession / Stalls

Arena

Procession

Stalls

Application numbers are up to approximately 30 and space is filling quite rapidly. Some regular plot holders' forms have yet to be received. Radio Norwich have requested that sponsors McDonalds are positioned next to them.

Contact has been made with Hellesdon Football Club and within the club there is a licensee and they also have a small group who are prepared to run the beer tent. The Deputy Clerk will liaise with them.

Freda Lane has confirmed that the Art Group are planning to hold an exhibition within the Community Centre on carnival day.
