

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the A1067 Drayton High Road - 1) from its junction with the A140 Boundary Road to its junction with Middletons Lane; and 2) south eastbound (into Norwich) only from its junction with Middletons Lane to its junction with Hellesdon Park Road in the PARISH OF HELLESDON because of works to improve the highway.

With effect from 9th January 2018 to 29th May 2018 road 1) will be temporarily subject to a 20 mph speed restriction and between 19:00 hrs to 06:00 hrs road 2) will be temporarily closed to prohibit travelling into Norwich (south eastbound) only (except for access) for the duration of the works, expected to be 142 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: A1067 Drayton High Road/ Fakenham Road, A1270 Northern Distributor Road, A140 Cromer Road/ Holt Road/ Boundary Road (Taverham/ Drayton/ Attlebridge/ Hellesdon/ Horsford).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

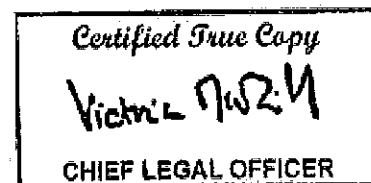

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HELLESDON)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION ORDER 2017
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984 SECTION 14(1)

ORDER restricting the use of the A1067 Drayton High Road:

- 1) from its junction with the A140 Boundary Road to its junction with Middletons Lane (hereinafter referred to as the said road (a)); and
- 2) south eastbound (into Norwich) only from its junction with Middletons Lane to its junction with Hellesdon Park Road (hereinafter referred to as the said road (b));

in the PARISH OF HELLESDON

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order and whereas the Norfolk County Council as Traffic Authority for the Administrative County of Norfolk is satisfied that works to improve the highway are required at the said road (b) in the PARISH OF HELLESDON and that in consequence with effect from 9th January 2018 to 29th May 2018:

- (i) traffic over the said road (a) should be restricted; and
- (ii) traffic over the said road (b) should be prohibited between the hours of 19:00 and 06:00;

for the duration of the works expected to be about 142 days within the period.

2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall make it unlawful for a vehicle which requires access, to proceed to a final destination situated within the length of road specified in Article 1 of this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces)(Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation n3(5) of those Regulations.
4. This Order has a maximum duration of 18 months and will be revoked upon completion of the works. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Order the operational period of this Order may become extended to allow completion of the works after obtaining consent of the Secretary of State.

NOW THEREFORE the Norfolk County Council DO HEREBY ORDER, that with effect from 9th January 2018 to 29th May 2018 for the duration of the works the said road (a) SHALL BE SUBJECT to the imposition of a 20mph speed restriction for the full duration of the closure and the said road (b) SHALL NOT BE USED by any class of vehicle between the hours of 19:00 and 06:00.
